2020 SKI SEASON GENERAL INFORMATION HEAVENLY NEVADA PROGRAM

Welcome to **ZEPHYR COVE SKI CLUB!!** This is a non-profit organization of parent volunteers who enjoy working with young people and helping them learn how to ski/snowboard. ZCSC is associated with the Douglas County School District and receives funding from the Douglas County Parks and Recreation Department to make this sporting experience available to our local youth.

SKI DATES:

Our program runs for six Saturdays beginning January 25th, 2020 (weather conditions permitting). If the program is cancelled on any scheduled ski day due to stormy weather conditions, you will be text messaged by 7:00AM that morning. If any cancellations occur during the season, our program dates will be extended to cover six Saturdays.

Program registration fees are not refundable due to non-attendance. Refunds will be considered for other reasons but will include a nonrefundable \$10.00 administration fee.

SAFETY FIRST !!

ZCSC participants will be under the supervision of Heavenly coaches only while they are in lesson groups (9:00 AM – 12:00PM). CHILDREN 8 YEARS AND YOUNGER NEED TO BE PICKED UP AT THE BOULDER LODGE AND SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT WHEN LESSONS END AT 12:00 NOON. ZCSC chaperones do not provide on mountain supervision. All club participants should always plan to ski/snowboard with a buddy or family member after they are finished with morning lessons.

TRANSPORTATION:

Transportation is provided by Douglas County School District buses with a ZCSC adult chaperone on board. All children must ride the bus in the morning which load at 8:00AM. Families may choose to use either Kahle Community Center bus stop or the Tina Court bus stop (top of Kingsbury off of Tramway).

A bus will be parked at Boulder Lodge all day if the children wish to leave additional gear or lunches on the bus. The bus will return to Kahle by 3:40PM. There are no afternoon stops at Tina Court. Children may choose to, but are not required to ride the bus home.

EQUIPMENT:

Skiers and Snowboarders are responsible for bringing all their own personal ski/snowboard equipment. Helmets are also required by Heavenly Ski area for all children enrolled in any ski or snowboarding lessons. All equipment should be clearly marked with the child's name.

Appropriate warm clothing, jackets and sunglasses are a must ... it's not fun to ski when you are cold! Extra clothing and lunches can be left on the bus. Please label everything.

CHAPERONES: (Interested in being a parent volunteer? See Bob Cook)

ZCSC chaperones are available to assist you and your child during our ski days. Please feel free to contact us during the week if a question should ever arise. Chaperone contact information is available on the website: www.zephyrcoveskiclub.com. Any program changes, weather cancellations, updates etc. will be communicated to our families via cell phone text messages. Please make sure that we have your correct text/cell phone information.

BUS AGREEMENT

Zephyr Cove Ski Club enforces a strict bus behavior code to enable the best supervised and safest transportation possible for our child. Our buses are provided by the Douglas County School District Transportation Department and we closely adhere to their rules of conduct.

Zephyr Cove Ski Club requires that you read these rules together with your child and sign the agreement as to the proper behavior on a school bus. We ask that you teach your child that the bus is a place to sit quietly, keep your hands to yourself and respect others' privacy to ensure the safety of all riders.

EXPECTED BUS BEHAVIOR

1. The bus driver and ski club chaperones are in complete charge of the bus and the children being transported to the ski area.
2. All riders must stay seated and facing forward at all times when the bus is in motion. All parts of the body must remain inside the bus.
3. No pushing or shoving while loading or unloading from the bus.
4. No throwing of anything at the bus, on the bus, or out the windows of the bus.
5. No loud or profane language.
6. Eating and drinking on the bus will be allowed only at lunchtime or at the driver's discretion.
7. The rear door of the bus is to be used for Emergencies only as directed by the bus driver.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

If any infractions occur or a child chooses to behave in a way that interferes with the driver, the following actions will be taken:

1st offense – WARNING!

2nd offense – Child shall ride in front with a chaperone and help with the loading and unloading of equipment.

3rd offense – Child shall be dropped from the ski club for the remainder of the season.

LEVEL	SKIERS	SNOWBOARDERS
1	THIS WILL BE YOUR FIRST TIME ON SKIS OR A SNOWBOARD.	
2	Skiers can stop and are working on turns.	Snowboarders can sideslip on their heel edge.
3	Skiers can make wedge turns, but want more control.	Snowboarders can turn to both edges, but want more control.
4	Skiers start turns in a wedge and finish with skis close to parallel.	Snowboarders can link toe and heel turns most of the time.
5	Skiers start turns with a slight wedge and finish with skis parallel.	Snowboarders can consistently link turns.
6	Skiers can consistently make parallel turns on green slopes.	Snowboarders can link toe and heel turns smoothly.
7	Skiers can consistently make parallel turns on blue slopes.	Snowboarders can adapt their turns to most blue slopes.

I further agree to reimburse and make good any loss, damage or cost that any of these parties may have to pay as a result of any such claim or if any litigations arises on account of any such claim, including attorney's fees and litigation expenses.

SKI SCHOOL & WINTER ACTIVITIES WARNING, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY & INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY & WAIVER OF CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS.

1. The person who is participating in the Activity (as defined below) is referred to as "Participant." If the Participant is 18 or older, the "Undersigned" means the Participant; if the Participant is under 18, it also includes the Participant's parent or legal guardian. The Undersigned understands that participating in ski and ride school, skiing, snowboarding, racing, ski simulation, training, tubing, ice skating, pond skimming, sledding, riding the alpine coaster, resort tours, other winter recreation, using freestyle or terrain park features, and using the ski area facilities, including the lifts, for any purpose (the "Activity"), can be **HAZARDOUS AND INVOLVE THE RISK OF PHYSICAL INJURY AND/OR DEATH.**
2. The Undersigned understands the dangers and risks of the Activity and that the Participant, as a "skier" (as may be defined by statute or other applicable law), **ASSUMES ALL INHERENT DANGERS AND RISKS.**
3. The Undersigned understands that he or she is expressly **acknowledging and assuming additional risks and dangers that may result in property damage, physical injury and/or death above and beyond the inherent dangers and risks of the Activity, including but not limited to:** Falling; exercising; free skiing; following the direction of an instructor or guide; avalanches; cornices; suffocation; crevasses; equipment malfunction, failure or damage; improper use or maintenance of equipment; slick or uneven surfaces; loss of balance; rugged mountainous terrain; bumps; tree wells; downed timber; rocks; holes; debris; marked and unmarked obstacles; drainage channels; varying visibility; unmaintained or unmarked trails/roads; trail obstructions; the negligence of Participant, an instructor (including selection of terrain that exceeds Participant's ability), or others; Participant's failure to comply with signage; collisions with natural or man-made objects or other people; encounters with snowmobiles and/or other motor vehicles; becoming lost or separated; lack of shelter; lift loading, unloading, and riding; storms, lightning, hail, snow and other adverse weather; limited access to and/or delay of medical attention; Participant's health condition; strenuous activity; exhaustion; dehydration; hypothermia; altitude sickness; frostbite; and/or mental distress from exposure to any of the above. **THE UNDERSIGNED UNDERSTANDS THAT THE DESCRIPTION OF THE RISKS IN THIS AGREEMENT IS NOT COMPLETE AND VOLUNTARILY CHOOSES FOR PARTICIPANT TO PARTICIPATE IN AND EXPRESSLY ASSUME ALL RISKS AND DANGERS OF THE ACTIVITY, WHETHER OR NOT DESCRIBED HERE, KNOWN OR UNKNOWN, INHERENT OR OTHERWISE.**
4. Participant assumes the responsibility of maintaining control at all times while engaging in the Activity and for reading, understanding and complying with all signage, including instructions on the use of lifts. Participant must have the physical dexterity and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload the lifts. The Undersigned understands that a minor Participant may use the ski lifts without an adult present. The Undersigned acknowledges that snowmobiles, snowmaking equipment, and snow-grooming equipment may be encountered at any time, and that falls, collisions, and injuries occur and are common.
5. If Participant rents equipment, the Undersigned agrees to accept for use the equipment rented "AS IS", accepts responsibility for the care of the equipment during the rental period, and agrees to be responsible for the replacement at full value of any equipment not returned or returned in a damaged condition. The Undersigned represents that no misrepresentations have been made in regards to the height, weight, age and/or skiing/snowboarding ability level of the Participant and represents that Participant will be the only person using the equipment. The Undersigned **UNDERSTANDS THAT THE BINDING SYSTEM CANNOT GUARANTEE THE USER'S SAFETY.** The binding system will not release at all times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release. The Undersigned further understands that the downhill ski binding system **DOES NOT REDUCE THE RISK OF ANY TYPE OF INJURY TO PARTICIPANT.** The Undersigned understands that in snowboarding, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and other sports utilizing equipment with non-release bindings, the binding system will not ordinarily release during use. The Undersigned agrees to assume and accept any and all known and unknown risks of injury to Participant while using this equipment.
6. Additionally, in consideration for allowing the Participant to participate in the Activity, **THE UNDERSIGNED AGREES TO HOLD HARMLESS, RELEASE, INDEMNIFY, AND NOT TO SUE** Vail Resorts, Inc., The Vail Corporation, Trimont Land Company, Heavenly Valley, Limited Partnership, and all of their affiliated companies and subsidiaries, including Burton, the United States, and all their respective insurance companies, successors in interest, commercial & corporate sponsors, affiliates, agents, employees, representatives, assignees, officers, directors, and shareholders (each a "Released Party") **FOR ANY PROPERTY DAMAGE, INJURY OR LOSS TO PARTICIPANT, INCLUDING DEATH, WHICH PARTICIPANT MAY SUFFER, ARISING IN WHOLE OR IN PART OUT OF PARTICIPANT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITY, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THOSE CLAIMS BASED ON ANY RELEASED PARTY'S ALLEGED OR ACTUAL NEGLIGENCE OR BREACH OF ANY CONTRACT AND/OR EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTY.**
7. The Undersigned represents that Participant is in good health and that there are no special problems associated with Participant's physical or mental condition. The Undersigned authorizes a licensed physician or other medical care provider to carry out any emergency medical care for Participant which may be necessary and agrees to be fully responsible for any costs associated with such care or transport to such care.
8. The Undersigned grants Vail Resorts the right of publicity to own and use any image collected of Participant while participating in the Activity.

9. The Undersigned agrees that any and all claims for loss, injury and/or death arising from the Participant's participation in the Activity shall be governed by the law of the state where the alleged incident occurred and that exclusive jurisdiction of any such claim shall be the state or federal court in the state where the alleged incident occurred, except that all cases arising out of an alleged incident at Heavenly shall be governed by California law and the exclusive jurisdiction of any such claim will be a California court of competent jurisdiction.

10. BY SIGNING ON BEHALF OF A MINOR, THE UNDERSIGNED REPRESENTS THAT HE OR SHE IS A LEGAL PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF THE PARTICIPANT and acknowledges that the Participant is bound by all the terms of this Agreement. By signing this Agreement without a parent or legal guardian's signature, Participant, under penalty of fraud, represents that he or she is at least 18 years old.

11. THE UNDERSIGNED AGREES TO INDEMNIFY THE RELEASED PARTIES FOR ALL LIABILITY AND CLAIMS, INCLUDING ATTORNEYS' FEES, ARISING FROM ANY MISREPRESENTATIONS OR FRAUDULENT EXECUTION OF THIS AGREEMENT.

12. The Undersigned understands that this Agreement is a contract and shall be binding to the fullest extent permitted by law on the Undersigned and his or her assignees, subrogors, distributors, heirs, next of kin, executors and personal representatives. If any part of this Agreement is deemed to be unenforceable, the remaining terms shall be an enforceable contract between the parties.
